

The Final Presentation


At the end of the course, groups present their work to receive feedback from their peers and experts. This is an opportunity to also celebrate their hard work and achievements with a formal graduation ceremony.

Guest speakers from various areas of this fascinating industry will join us in London to talk about their experience, how they got to where they are and what they have learned along the way.



Business projects may include innovation towards a greener future in the UK or developing a response to the growing housing crisis.

Industry Workshops

To support our Business Management project work, we spend time off campus in the industry.

Workshops include brand development with a global advertising agency, a pitching master class with the School of Life and visits to leading start-up hubs across London to learn from those changing the world of business.

Experience-Based Learning

Site visits include destinations like the Museum of Brands, the Bank of England, the financial district at Canary Wharf and Docklands.

Participants will join a London Assembly public meeting to gain an insight into the public sector, plus experience recent urban regeneration with a tour of the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park, home of the 2012 Olympic Games.

As part of panel discussions and through TEDx-style events, our guest speakers offer an insight into the world of business.



Industry Workshops

To support ongoing project work, participants spend significant time off-campus visiting industry-related destinations.

Visits include excursions to London's most influencial creative writing and publishing houses, and industry visits to renowned film studios.

Experience-Based Learning

Students will gain insight from creating projects that blend their own experiences with the learnings from top academics in the field of creative writing and film.

Participants will have excursions to the most well-known galleries, including a visit to Oxford and Cambridge - home to some of the greatest writers in history.

Guest Speakers

Exposure to excellent guest speakers offers an insight into the world of creative writing and film, with top professionals in the industry coming to speak on topics such as exploring genre as well as industry-based insights - how to get a film from script to screen.

Engineering

Project-based Sessions

Engineering project options range from the design of an artificial intelligence tool, transforming the farming industry or the development of a scheme to improve urban transport around London.

Using real-world data, cohorts will innovate to offer future-proof solutions to problems facing our societies.

Industry Workshops

Exposure to the industry brings future careers to life. Workshops may include a session with the globally recognised Dyson Institute, a robotics master class with the School of Coding plus visits to industry heavyweights like Jaguar Land Rover or Transport for London and the companies changing the world of engineering.

Experience-Based Learning

On the Engineering programme, academic trips can include visits to the London Transport Museum's 'Secrets of The Underground' exhibit and David Kirkaldy's Testing and Experimenting Works.

In addition, students will also experience a full social programme including a theatre visit to the West End, outdoor cinema, museum events, talent show and more.



Participants will explore current issues in the world of fine art and form an understanding of them whilst working on their own personal project, supported by expert academics.

Industry Workshops

Fine Art participants will enjoy excursions to worldfamous exhibtions and museums where they will explore and gain insight into the world of art history as well as contemporary modern art, sculpture, and instllation art.

Within these excursions, students will be able to envisage where their own work would fit in the art world.

Experience-Based Learning

Ages 13-15 & Ages 16-18, London





Project-based Sessions

High-quality learning relies on young adults developing the confidence to share their ideas and put their skills into practice.

This is why the real-world project sits at the heart of Career Insights, giving participants an opportunity to create something of value in preparation for a future in their chosen industry.

Industry Workshops

To support ongoing project work, participants spend significant time off-campus visiting industry-related destinations.

Visits could include a session at the Royal Courts of Justice, a workshop at the Law Society or meetings with barristers, paralegals and solicitors across many areas of law.

Experience-Based Learning

On the Law programme, trips can include visits to the UK Houses of Parliament, The University of Law, The Supreme Court and the Royal Courts of Justice.

We will join a London Assembly public meeting to get an insight into the workings of law in relation to the public sector, and visit the Old Bailey, the capital's principal criminal court.

Guest Speakers

Exposure to excellent guest speakers offer an insight into the world of legal executives, solicitors, barristers and law makers.

Our speakers have academic experience from Harvard Law School, the University of Oxford and Cambridge, with experience at 'Magic Circle' law firms including Clifford Chance and city firms such as Taylor Wessing LLP.



Medicine

Ages 13-15 & Ages 16-18, London





Project-based Sessions

Projects on the Medicine course involve students selecting a medical condition of interest, then using relevant real-world data to explore diagnosis, treatment plans and the social implications.

Discovering the viewpoint of a General Practitioner, students will work through stages of testing, diagnosis, referrals and a treatment plan.

Industry Workshops

Spending time in the industry brings our project work to life. Workshops could include a session at the Old Operating Theatre, the Florence Nightingale Museum or the Science Museum. We will focus on the rapid advances being made in medical technology.

Experience-Based Learning

As part of our Medicine programme, academic visits can include the Anaesthesia Heritage Centre, the Old Operating Theatre and St Bartholomew's Hospital Museum.

Throughout the programme, participants explore medical history from 1750 to the present day, and join a meeting at the London Assembly for an insight into current public health issues facing society.

Guest Speakers

Inspiring guest speakers bring to life the huge range of roles open to those looking to work in a field of Medicine.

Our speakers have a wealth of experience across the industry, from world-leading hospitals, research facilities, global healthcare communications agencies and international humanitarian NGOs like Médecins Sans Frontières.
